Topic: “Case History – Kentucky River Lock and Dam No. 8”

Speaker: Adam Hacker

Adam Hacker will present a presentation that will cover the Kentucky River Lock and Dam No. 8 Renovation project, which is located just south of Nicholasville, Kentucky. This case history will cover a historical background of the project site from its original construction over 110 years ago to current conditions after several repairs to mitigate leakage. Additionally, this case history will discuss the geotechnical exploration conducted by Stantec in 2011 and foundation improvement measures taken to address water quantity and quality issues for the cities of Nicholasville and Lancaster, Kentucky.

Adam is a graduate of the University of Louisville with a Bachelors degree in Civil Engineering and a Masters Degree in Geotechnical Engineering in July 2010. Adam works for Stantec out of Lexington, Kentucky as a Geotechnical Engineer.
