Hugo Aparacio, PEis a vice president in Stantec's Geotechnical Engineering practice area, which was created within Stantec after the 2008 acquisition of Fuller, Mossbarger, Scott and May Engineers (FMSM).

Hugo has over 40 years of experience in overseeing the geotechnical aspects of a variety of civil engineering projects, including dams; levees; highways; bridges; abandoned mine land reclamations; residential, commercial, and industrial developments; waterfront structures; buildings; and storage tanks.



He has also prepared complete design documents for numerous projects involving the construction of dams, levees, landslide stabilization measures, site grading, and different types of retaining structures. He leads most of the practice area projects dealing with landslide evaluation and repair design, after having performed work on over 500 projects of this type. Additionally, he is engaged in most of the projects of the practice area where karst issues are relevant by providing guidance to his peers and clients in the exploration and treatment of karst features. Hugo has worked on numerous dam and roadway embankment projects requiring the planning, installation, and monitoring of various types of geotechnical instrumentation. He began his engineering career by gaining invaluable and practical experience while serving as an assistant resident engineer for a 30-mile (48-kilometre)-long major highway construction project involving nine million cubic yards (over 8 million cubic metres) of earthwork.

More recently, Hugo's work has been focused primarily on providing geotechnical and civil engineering services as a member of Stantec's core team serving the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA), evaluating the stability of large earth dams and ash disposal facilities, designing stabilization measures for some of these facilities and monitoring the construction of these measures.

Hugo graduated from the University of Kentucky with bachelor's and master's degrees in civil engineering. Outside the office, Hugo is an avid golfer and traveler.
