Topic: “Geotechnical Grouting – Materials, Techniques and Case Histories”

R. Michael Bivens, PE will present a one-hour presentation that will cover materials, mixing and pumping of chemical grouts, cementitious grout, and compaction grout. During the presentation, time will be taken to proportion chemical and cementitious grouts and demonstrate the modification of viscosity and thixotropy for cementitious grouts. The “old-school” grouting philosophy will be contrasted with modern, stable mix designs. Case histories will also be presented.
