Topics: **Kentucky Geological Survey (KGS) Cooperatively Effort with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Geotechnical Branch to Integrate Geologic and Geotechnical Data for Web Distribution**

Speaker: Jerry Weisenfluh, Geospatial Analysis Section of KGS.

The Kentucky Geological Survey has been working cooperatively with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Geotechnical Branch to integrate geologic and geotechnical data for Web distribution. One project involved cataloging roadway and structural reports to make them available to the public. This application allowed KYTC staff to upload reports to the system and catalog descriptive information about them. A Web page is now available for searching over 5000 historical reports, and an interactive Web map can be used to view the locations of the projects.

KGS has also been preparing a Web service for providing geologic maps and associated site data to the public. This Web map allows users to customize the layout of the map for their project needs and overlay site data, such as oil wells or sinkhole locations. In the future, KYTC geotechnical drill holes will be added to the map.

Jerry Weisenfluh is head of the Geospatial Analysis section at KGS. His background is in coal geology, GIS, and database technology.
